Bunker Hill Road Slide Repair Project:

Cowlitz County road crews have completed slide repairs in the 100 block of Bunker Hill Road. The road is now fully open to travel. Loose gravel remains in the uphill lane and will be rough until paved. Paving is expected to take place in a few weeks.

Guardrail Repair & Replacement Project:

Columbia River Contractors, under contract with Cowlitz County, is continuing to install and repair guardrails in the rural Kalama area.

Delameter Road Reconstruction Project:

C & R Tractor and Landscaping, under contract with Cowlitz County, is continuing work on the Delameter Road Reconstruction Project from Milepost 0.90 to 2.33 (Cline Road to Melton Road) west of Castle Rock.

Sauer Road Slide Repair Project:

Pile Contractors Inc., under contract with Cowlitz County, is continuing construction of a new retaining wall as part of the Sauer Road Slide Repair Project (Milepost 1.07 to 1.10) in rural Kalama. Traffic is reduced to one lane through the construction zone.

West Side Highway Slide Repair Project:

Steele Trucking, Inc., under contract with Cowlitz County, will begin construction on the West Side Highway Slide Repair Project (Milepost 2.47) on Monday, November 18, 2019. Minor road delays are expected.

Please use caution near construction zones and obey the directions of construction personnel and traffic control devices. Road maintenance and construction projects are weather dependent. Heavy rain or freezing conditions can slow or postpone operations. Projected schedules are approximate.
