2020 Countywide Pavement Overlay Project:

Drivers may encounter delays due to paving for the 2020 Countywide Overlay Project. Lakeside Industries, under contract with Cowlitz County, is scheduled to begin asphalt paving on **Wednesday, July 1 in the Castle Rock area**. After the Castle Rock area, paving will shift to rural Woodland, followed by rural Longview, Beacon Hill, and the rural Kelso area. Paving operations are dependent on weather and are expected to require approximately four weeks to complete. Updated scheduling will be released weekly.

Roads scheduled for Overlay Paving (in approximate order) include: Hazel Dell Road, Melton Road, Monahan Road, Delameter Road, Parker Road, Headquarters Road, South Silver Lake Road, Dougherty Drive, Powell Road, Castle Rock Sports Complex, Martin's Bluff Road, Shirley Gordon Road, Green Mountain Road, Little Kalama River Road, Butte Hill Road, Insel Road, Finn Hall Road, Fredrickson Road, Merwin Village Road, Mill Creek Road, Oak Point Road, Cathlamet Road, Bunker Hill Road, Beacon Hill Road, Kool Road, Olsen Road, Norwood Drive, Pare Drive, County portion of Tennant Way and Maple Hill Road. Flaggers will be present as one lane will be closed. Drivers should expect delays of up to 15 minutes between 7:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. in the active work zones.

Please use caution near construction zones and obey the directions of construction personnel and traffic control devices.

Paint striping, chip sealing, overlay paving, culvert replacements and road improvements are scheduled throughout the summer.
