LFCZD Sparks Drive Pump Station Repaired

The Board of Supervisors of the Lexington Flood Control Zone District approved an emergency declaration for repairs at a special meeting on September 23, 2020. The replacement parts were installed Wednesday morning and the Sparks Drive Pump Station has returned to normal operations. Crews will continue to closely monitor the pump station for several weeks to ensure that all systems remain normal.

Supervisors and staff are thoroughly evaluating the existing control system, and manual bypass, to determine what, if any, changes should occur to ensure the operational reliability of the pump station throughout all weather conditions.
