Recycling Used Motor Oil & Antifreeze

HOW TO PROPERLY RECYCLE USED OIL IN COWLITZ COUNTY:

- Step 1 – Pour oil into a plastic container with a screw-top lid. Please do not mix oil with other material such as antifreeze, brake fluid or gasoline.
- Step 2 – Transport oil to one of the 12 oil drop off sites available in Cowlitz County and pour oil into the collection tank. (Site locations listed below)
- Step 3 – Reuse plastic container or drain for 24 hours and place in trash.
