RAPE OF CHILD 1, INDECENT LIBS



According to official documents, in 1992 Reichert was convicted of Rape of a Child 1st degree and Indecent Liberties in Lewis County. Reichert had sexual contact with an initially unknown 8-year-old male. The sexual abuse spanned from 1986 to 1989. Mr. Reichert was released from custody on 9/15/04 for a DOC violation where he visited a park when children were present, a violation of his probation. Reichert was allowed to participate in community based sexual deviancy treatment. He subsequently violated the terms of a suspended sentence by failing to comply with sexual deviancy treatment. During his incarceration Reichert completed Sex Offender Treatment.

The Longview Police Department is releasing this information pursuant to RCW 4.24.550 and the Washington State Supreme Court decision State v. Ward, which authorizes law enforcement agencies to inform the public of a sex offender release when, at the discretion of the Agency and the Risk Assessment Committee, the information will enhance public safety and protection. The sex offender listed has served the sentence imposed by the courts and has advised the Longview Police Dept. and the Cowlitz County Sheriff's Office of their address. This Registered Offender is not wanted at this time. This notification is not intended to increase fear; rather it is our belief that an informed public is a safer public. Law enforcement agencies have no legal authority to direct where a sex offender may or may not live. Unless court ordered restrictions exist, this offender is constitutionally free to live anywhere. Citizen abuse of this information to threaten or harass registered sex offenders will not be tolerated. Such abuse could potentially end law enforcement's ability to do community notifications. SOME SUGGESTIONS FOR SELF-PROTECTION:

1. You and your children should be continually aware of who is around you. If they are unfamiliar to you, don't put yourself in jeopardy.
2. Be aware of where your children are. Try to establish a time share child watching effort for children playing in the neighborhood.
3. Establish neighborhood safe havens for children as well as adults.
4. Urge your children to play in the area of other children, and caution them to not go anywhere with strangers.
5. Plan methods of escape, routes of escape and methods of self protection
