**WHAT IS THE CYSHCN PROGRAM?**

Children and Youth with Special Health

Care Needs (CYSHCN) is a federal and state-funded program offered locally by Cowlitz County Health & Human Services.

The program connects children with special needs to essential services in the community.

**WHO IS ELIGIBLE FOR SERVICES?**

Children age 17 years-old or younger who have – or who are at risk of developing – a chronic physical, developmental, behavioral, or mental health condition.

Eligible participants require health and related services that are beyond what is generally recommended.

**WHAT SERVICES ARE OFFERED?**

Cowlitz County CYSHCN coordinators and public health

nurses provide support to families over the phone for **FREE**. Services include:

- Assessing the child's needs and offer referrals to services
- Coordinating with agencies to best support the child
- Connecting families to parent support organizations
- Helping with concerns, such as feeding, nutrition, growth, development and behavior
