COWLITZ COMMUNITY NETWORK

July 1, 2019 – June 30, 2020 \$10,000

Financial Literacy

Financial Literacy training for at-risk youth and families who have very low incomes, are homeless or at risk of homelessness, or are financially vulnerable. Training topics include, but are not limited to: Bank on It, Setting Financial Goals, Borrowing Basics, and Saving for Cars and College.

EMERGENCY SUPPORT SHELTER

July 1, 2019 – June 30, 2020 \$104,189.00

Shelter Operations & Coordinated Entry

Emergency Shelter for victims of domestic violence as well as supportive services including: crisis intervention, safety planning, case management, goal setting for post shelter stay, legal advocacy, and support groups. Also serves as a Coordinated Entry access point for victims fleeing violence.

LOVE OVERWHELMING

July 1, 2019 – December 31, 2019

Coordinated Entry - \$85,551.47

Easy access and assessment for specific housing resources and other community resources. Coordinated Entry prevents and diverts as often as possible, and connects those needing housing resources to the most appropriate resource. Also refers to other community resources such as food, primary care, behavioral health, DSHS, etc.

LOVE OVERWHELMING

July 1, 2019 – October 31, 2019

Permanent Supportive Housing - \$37,773.00

Scattered site permanent supportive housing provides supportive services to help obtain and maintain permanent housing for up to 50 high-risk individuals.

LOWER COLUMBIA CAP

July 1, 2019 – June 30, 2020

Low Barrier Housing Project - \$96,278

Housing with supportive services to 6 chronically homeless, high-risk adult individuals. Supports include case management, case conferencing and coordination with other key service providers, assistance securing income benefits, increase housing stability and self-sufficiency.
