



No Shooting Area

Property owners of an area may request establishment of a “no shooting area” by petition of at least 60% of the ownership of the defined area. The defined area may not include an established outdoor public shooting range.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- Application form
- Legal Description of the proposed boundaries of the no shooting area, along with map of subject parcel boundaries
- Written statement, utilizing standards from Cowlitz County Code Section 10.20.025 detailing reasons for proposed no shooting area
- Petition signed by not less than 60% of the property owners within the proposed no shooting area
- Application fee

REVIEW PROCESS

The Department of Building and Planning reviews No Shoot Area applications for compliance with County Code, and forwards to the Board of County Commissioners for review during an open public hearing.

FEE SCHEDULE

The following fee is required to be paid when the application is submitted.
