Who is eligible for assistance?

Veterans who have:

- “Honorable” or “general” (under honorable conditions) discharge from service
- Identification
- Income eligibility
- Residency in Cowlitz County for at least 90 days

Families of deceased veterans may also be able to receive assistance the first 18 months after the death of an eligible veteran.
