



Spill Kit Program

Learn how to prevent spills and clean them up when they happen.

Preventing spills is the first step to minimizing the risks associated with spills. Here are some simple steps to prevent spills:

Inventory your business

to know where liquids are stored, handled, delivered and disposed of at your site. Locate all drains and determine if they lead to sanitary sewer or stormwater.

Secure liquids at each of these locations to prevent accidental spills from knocking containers over or allowing containers to rupture or leak.

Develop a plan to know how to clean up spills safely. Train employees on spill kit use and, if needed, notify regulatory authorities: Washington State Department of Ecology's **24-Hour Hotline 360.407.6300**.
