

Special Absentee Ballot Application

RCW 29A.40.050 | WAC 434-250-030

Important information

Washington State votes entirely by mail. Ballots are mailed to registered voters at least 18 days before each election, or 45 days before an election for registered service and overseas voters. Registered voters do not need to request a regular mail-in ballot. You can confirm your registration status and information by visiting VoteWA.gov or contacting your County Elections Department.

If it is within 90 days prior to a state Primary or General Election and you believe that you will be unable to access, vote, and return a regularly-issued mail ballot within the time provided by law, complete and return this form to your County Elections Department.

You may also request a regular ballot, vote it, and return it. If both ballots are voted and received in time, the regular ballot will be counted instead of the special absentee ballot.
