## Where does this funding come from?

The WA State Attorney General’s Office (AGO) worked on behalf of the State of WA to seek damages from opioiD pharmaceutical and distribution companies for their role in the rise of opioiD use. These funds are the result of settlements related to those lawsuits.

Receipt of funds from settlements began in early 2023 and some settlement payments will continue for 17 years.

There are multiple lawsuits. The funding listed below reflects the settlements known to-date. This includes Pharmacy/Manufacturer Settlement (Teva, CVS, Walmart, Allergan, Walgreens); Initial Distributor Settlement (McKesson, Cardinal Health, AmerisourceBergen Drug); Johnson & Johnson/Janssen Settlement.

There may be additional settlements in the future.

## How can this funding be used?

As outlined in the agreements made in the lawsuits, opioiD settlement funds can be used for various opioiD mitigation strategies such as the treatment and prevention of opioiD disorders.

The Cowlitz County Board of County Commissioners makes funding decisions and relies on Cowlitz County Health & Human Services (CCHHS) to administer the funds.
