



SUMMARY

Cowlitz County is required to have a Coordinated Entry system that provides a streamlined process to access, assess, and refer to *specific* housing programs in the community. These specific housing programs have limited availability and program openings are contingent upon capacity and/or availability of funds. Coordinated Entry *does not* provide emergency services or housing, and referrals to the specific housing programs are not immediate and happen rarely.

The Resource Screening asks individuals seeking assistance basic demographic and other information to assist with referrals and connecting to mainstream services.






INDIVIDUALS BY GENDER:




INDIVIDUALS BY AGE:




