**THIS ADDENDUM IS HEREBY MADE A PART OF THE CONTRACT DOCUMENTS TO THE SAME EXTENT AS THOUGH IT WAS ORIGINALLY INCLUDED THEREIN.**

**PROPOSAL**

Quantities for Structural Fill Including Haul, Crushed Surfacing Base Course, and HMA Class 3/8 Inch PG 58H-22 have been revised. The Proposal Form is replaced with the attached revised Proposal Form.

**BID ITEM 8: ROADWAY EXCAVATION, EMBANKMENT AND DISPOSAL INCLUDING HAUL**

**BID ITEM 9: ROCK EXCAVATION INCLUDING HAUL**

**BID ITEM 10: UNSUITABLE FOUNDATION EXCAVATION INCLUDING HAUL**

**2-03.1 Description**

Add the following to Section 2-03.1:

(\*\*\*\*\*)

The bid item Roadway Excavation, Embankment and Disposal Including Haul also includes all channel excavation. It is the County's intent to maximize use of the channel excavation material for streambed construction in lieu of using the Channel Fill Material Including Haul bid item.

**2-03.3(2) Rock Cuts**

Add the following to Section 2-03.3(2):

(\*\*\*\*\*)

The bid item Rock Excavation Including Haul is for all rock excavation within the limits of roadway excavation. Rock excavation within the limits of structure excavation is included in the bid item Structure Excavation Class A Incl. Haul.

**BID ITEM 11: STRUCTURE EXCAVATION CLASS A INCL. HAUL**

**BID ITEM 12: SHORING OR EXTRA EXCAVATION CLASS A**

**2-09.4 Measurement**

Add the following to Section 2-09.4:

(\*\*\*\*\*)

The calculated volume of structure excavation is 2,424 cubic yards, measured from the bottom of structure excavation (and channel excavation within the new culvert) to existing ground and bounded by the horizontal limits of structure excavation shown on the Plans. This volume includes the existing concrete box culvert. Removal of the concrete box culvert is paid under the bid item Removal of Structures and Obstructions.

**2-09.5 Payment**

Add the following to Section 2-09.5:

(\*\*\*\*\*)

Structural fill placed within the limits of structure excavation shall be included in the lump sum contract price for Structure Excavation Class A Incl. Haul. When extra excavation is used in lieu of constructing shoring, structural fill shall also be required as backfill material for the extra excavation at the Contractor's expense.

**BID ITEM 45: CHANNEL FILL MATERIAL INCLUDING HAUL**

**8-30 STREAMS, RIVERS, AND WATERBODIES**

**8-30.1 Description**

(\*\*\*\*\*)

Add the following to Section 8-30.1:

This work also consists of creating boulder clusters within the reconstructed streambed.

**8.30.2 Materials**

(\*\*\*\*\*)

Add the following to Section 8-30.2:

An additional 90 tons of Streambed Boulders Type 1 shall be used to create boulder clusters as shown on the Plans.

**8-30.3 Construction Requirements**

(\*\*\*\*\*)

Add the following to Section 8-30.3:

Streambed boulders type 1 shall be placed in boulder clusters as shown on the Plans. Channel fill

material shall be placed around the boulder clusters and within the interstitial spaces between individual boulders in the boulder clusters.

**8-30.4 Measurement**

Add the following to Section 8-30.4:

(\*\*\*\*\*)

Only material imported from offsite sources and meeting the requirements of this Special Provision will be measured. Excavated material from the Roadway, Excavation, Embankment and Disposal Including Haul bid item that are stockpiled and/or placed in the streambed will not be measured for this bid item.

**8-30.5 Payment**

(\*\*\*\*\*)

Add the following to Section 8-30.5:


The unit contract price per ton shall also be full pay for creating the boulder clusters as described in Section 8-30.3.

**INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS**

**1. Contract Documents.** See Section 1-04.2 of the Special Provisions for a list of the "contract documents" that make up the contract. Be sure that you have a copy of the **2025** Standard Specifications for Road, Bridge, and Municipal Construction, by the Washington State Department of Transportation and the American Public Works Association, Washington State Chapter. Such specifications are sometimes referred to as the "Standard Specifications."

**2. Submission of Bid.** Fill out this Proposal Form completely, in accordance with Section 1-02.6 of the Standard Specifications. Enclose your Proposal Form and bid deposit in an opaque sealed envelope addressed to:

Mark the outside of the envelope with the name of the bidder, the name of the project, and the date and time of the bid opening. It is your responsibility to make sure that your bid is physically received by the Department of Public Works by the time set for the bid opening. Bids not so received will not be considered. Bids may not be submitted by facsimile machine.

The County's determination of when a bid was received shall be final and non-appealable.

**3. Bidder Responsibility Standards.** It is the intent of the Owner to award a contract to the lowest, responsible and responsive bidder for all described Work. Before award, the bidder must meet all criteria and satisfy all requirements of the following bidder-responsibility standards to be considered a responsible and a responsive bidder. The bidder may be required by the Owner to submit documentation demonstrating compliance with these standards to be qualified to be awarded a contract. The bidder must:

- a. Have a current certificate of registration as a contractor in compliance with chapter 18.27 RCW, which must have been in effect at the time of bid submittal;
- b. Have a current Washington Unified Business Identifier (UBI) number;
- c. If applicable:
  - i. Have Industrial Insurance (workers' compensation) coverage for the bidder's employees working in Washington, as required in Title 51 RCW;
  - ii. Have a Washington Employment Security Department number, as required in Title 50 RCW;
  - iii. Have a Washington Department of Revenue state excise tax registration number, as required in Title 82 RCW;
- d. Not be disqualified from bidding on any public works contract under RCW 39.06.010 or 39.12.065(3).

**4. Execution of Contract.** The successful bidder must use the performance bond form and other forms provided by Cowlitz County to be considered both a responsible and responsive bidder.

**5. Sales Tax Code.** In computing and reporting sales taxes payable to the Washington State Department of Revenue on this project, the following code number shall be used: **0800**.
