The Cowlitz County Board of Commissioners announces vacancies on advisory boards and committees:

Solid Waste Advisory Committee – Terms are 2 years. Updates and reviews Solid Waste Management Plan; review and comment on policies concerning solid waste handling and disposal; review fees and ordinance prior to adoption. Applicants must reside in Cowlitz County.

Diking Improvement District No. 15 – Willow Grove Area. West of Longview, provides flood protection and drainage, operates and maintains dikes, drainage ditches and pump station. Applicants must be a property owner within the district and a registered voter in the state of Washington.

Rural Partial County Library District Trustee - Terms are 5 years, cannot serve more than two consecutive terms. Manages and controls the district and finances, submits an annual budget and sets the tax levy.

Veterans Advisory Board – Terms are 4 years, meet quarterly. Members advise the commissioners on the needs, the resources available and the programs that could benefit the needs of local indigent veterans and their families; only veterans are eligible to serve as board members and should belong to a nationally recognized veteran service organization.

Park & Recreation Advisory Board - Terms are 6 Years, Expire in June, Meet 2nd Tuesday 5:30 p.m. District No. 2. Advises on acquisition, improvement and maintenance of county parks, playgrounds and facilities.

Building and Planning Advisory Council - Terms are 4 Years. District No. 1. Review of the department's work plan, stakeholder and customer input practices, service levels, process performance, implementation of new technology and developing new regulatory guidelines and standards.

Fair Board – 4 Year Terms, Meet 1st Monday of the month at 6:30 p.m. Members responsible for making recommendations for the general development, production and operation of the fair.

Rodeo Board - 4-year Terms, Meets the last Tuesday of the month at 6 p.m. Members responsible for making recommendations for the general development, production and operation of the rodeo. Meets at 6 p.m. the last Tuesday of the month

Food Advisory Committee—Responsible for making recommendations for a pro-active food advisory program that promotes and protects the health, safety, and well-being of the public, and prevents the spread of disease by food.
